II Thessalonians 3:6-15, Genesis 2:15, 3:17-19, Titus 2:9-10

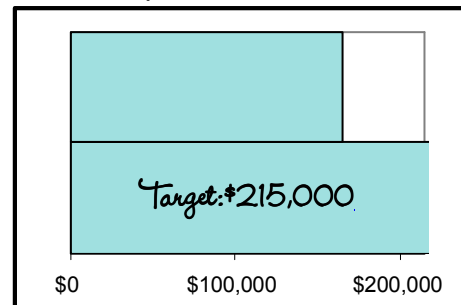

4. How does my work connect with the Gospel and Jesus' mission for me in the world?

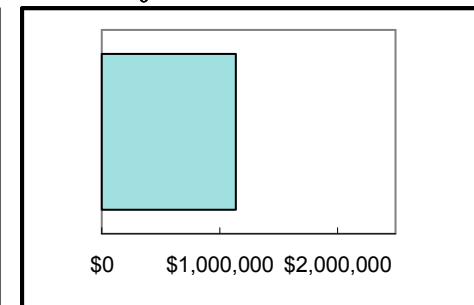
