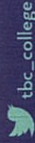

# What are the Core Values

## of Temple Bible Church?

*Everything we do is influenced by three core values which we believe are at the heart of what it is to be the people of God.*

### Surrender

**Personal Surrender to Christ** – The gospel calls us to personally surrender to Jesus Christ as Lord. This is more than a one time

event, but includes the continuing process of giving up control of our own lives daily, dying to ourselves, and submitting everything to the desires of our Savior (Luke 14:25-33). We demonstrate our love for Jesus by living out this truth (John 14:23-24).

### Community

**Authentic Biblical Community** – Jesus says that the world will know we are his disciples by how we visibly love other

believers (John 13:34-35). He calls us to share life together in biblical community where we can live out the one another's of Scripture before a watching world. One example of how this looks is found in Acts 2:42-47. True biblical community stands in stark contrast to the extreme individualism of our culture.

### Mission

**Sacrificial, Missional Living** – Christ has sent us into the world to be about his mission (John 20:21).

This mission takes precedence over our own desires and comes with a cost in our personal lives. We want to see Christ's kingdom advance in all aspects of society and see the community of believers grow both locally and around the world (Matthew 28:19). We want to continually call Christians away from worldly distractions and back to the mission that has been given us (2 Timothy 2:4).

## Distinct But Not Separate

Though there are three distinct Core Values, they are not to be viewed as separate or independent of one another. The circles serve as a visual reminder of how they are interrelated. Each Core Value is best understood when described in relationship to the other two.

Personal surrender to Christ involves dying to ourselves and living for Him. This is not simply a private inward reality, but can only truly be done in the context of others, in biblical community. This is where all the one another's of Scripture like loving, serving, and forgiving one another can be lived out in close relationships. In this way personal surrender is tied to life lived in community.

But the experience of Christian community is not an end in itself. It is not to be hoarded. Just as the individual must die to himself in the context of the community, so also the community must be faithful to its mission and die to itself as it reaches out to "the other", those outside the community, and brings them inside.

The community is only truly biblical when it exists and functions in the context of carrying out the mission of Christ and seeing the community expand and grow. One way we communicate this is through the expression, "We are not on a mission of community, but rather we are a community on a mission."
