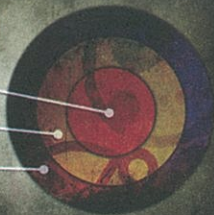

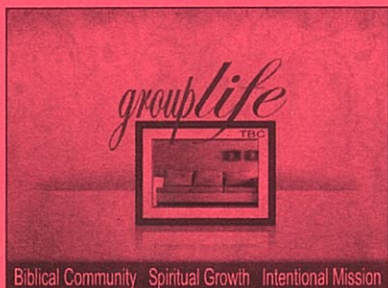
OVERFLOW HS EQUIP GROUPS
