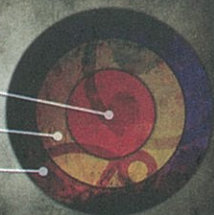

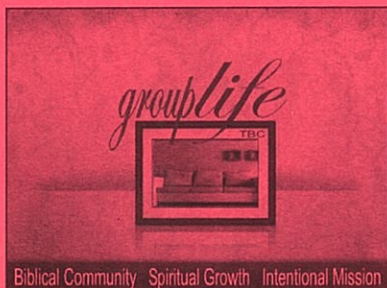
BABY DEDICATION
