Dr. Wallace is the Senior Professor of New Testament Studies at Dallas Theological Seminary where he has taught for almost 3 decades. He is also the founder and Executive Director of the Center for the Study of New Testament Manuscripts. Dr. Wallace has authored many books including *Reinventing Jesus*. He is one of the world's foremost authorities on textual criticism of Scripture. He is a member of several scholarly societies. His postdoctoral work includes work on Greek grammar at Tyndale House in Cambridge. He is in demand as a speaker at churches, colleges, and conferences. Dr. Wallace and his wife, Pati, have four adult sons, three daughters in-law, three granddaughters, and a Labrador Retriever.
