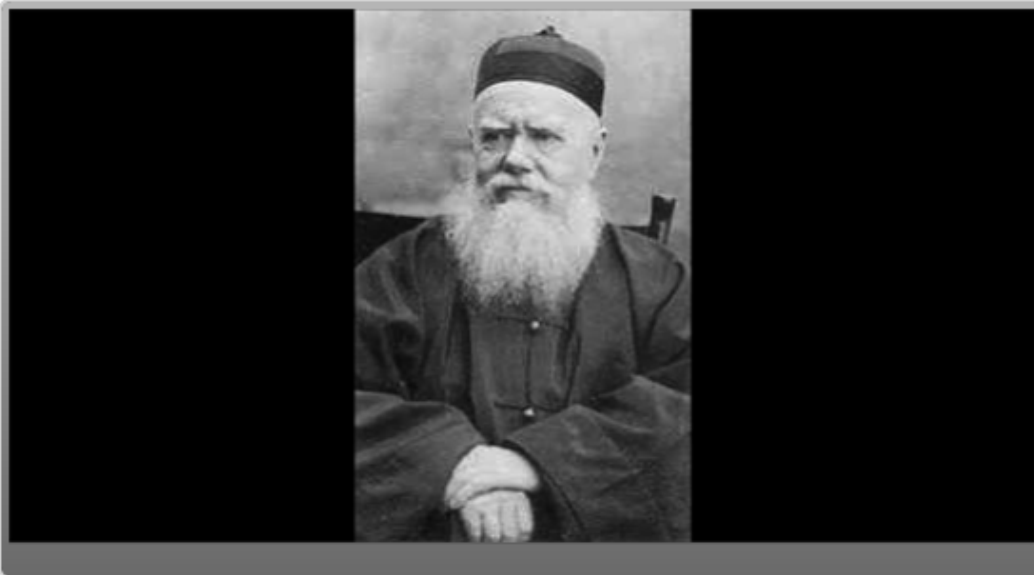
Mark 9:15

1 Corinthians 9:20-23



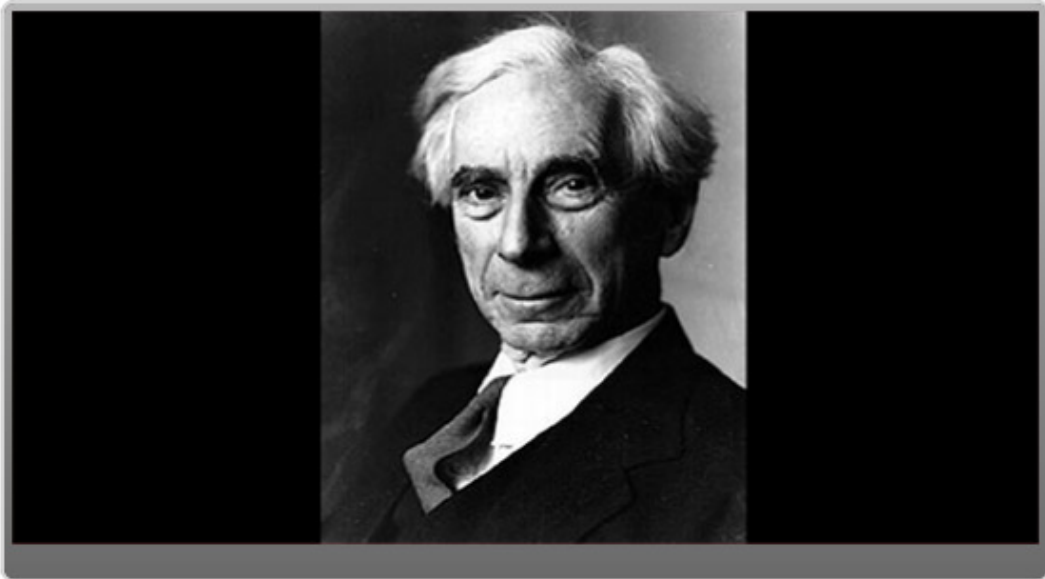
"Early on we discovered that it was not enough for Christians to feel pity or even just affection for the city. Staff and leaders had to humbly learn from and respect the culture and its people.
