# What is Paul talking about when he refers to the gift of prophecy?

- 1. This is not equivalent to Old Testament prophecy authored by God himself. It is not infallible, authoritative or canon threatening.
- 2. The prophecy referred to here would fall under what Charles Spurgeon referred to as "impressions of the Holy Spirit".

#### Prophecy

The specific secrets of an individual's heart being disclosed, demonstrating the reality of God and his intimate knowledge of individuals, and pointing to the validity of the Christian gospel.

### The Greek Word "Phonai" – Languages

The Greek Word "Aphonos" – Without Meaning

- 1. Prophecy must come from a place of <u>HUMILITY</u> and it must be done in <u>COMMUNITY!</u>
- 2. Prophecy has the opportunity to attach <a href="RELEVANCE">RELEVANCE</a> and <a href="APPLICATION">APPLICATION</a> to what was heard in Scripture.
