


GOOD AND GRACIOUS KING

WHY EMPHASIZE MINISTRY TO CHILDREN AND YOUTH?

- 19 out of 20 received Christ before the age of 25
- at 25, 1 in 10,000 will become believers
- at 35, 1 in 50,000
- at 45, 1 in 200,000
- at 55, 1 in 300,000
- at 75, 1 in 700,000

D.L. Moody once returned from a meeting and reported two and a half conversions. "Two adults and a child, I suppose?" asked his host. "No," said Moody, "two children and an adult. The children gave their whole lives. The adult had only half of his left to give."

And as he was setting out on his journey, a man ran up and knelt before him and asked him, "Good Teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?" And Jesus said to him, "Why do you call me good? No one is good except God alone. You know the commandments: 'Do not murder, Do not commit adultery, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Do not defraud, Honor your father and mother." And he said to him, "Teacher, all these I have kept from my youth." And Jesus, looking at him, loved him, and said to him, "You lack one thing: go, sell all that you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, follow me." Disheartened by the saying, he went away sorrowful, for he had great possessions.

MARK 10:17-22

There are two words used to describe the man,
"disheartened & sorrowful".

This tells us that he really had some kind of desire to pursue Jesus and experience eternal life. BUT his things, the lifestyle, the notoriety, the influence, the future, control were too much to give up. He couldn't bring himself to HELPLESS DEPENDENCE.

And the disciples were amazed at his words. But Jesus said to them again, "Children, how difficult it is to enter the kingdom of God! It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich person to enter the kingdom of God." Mark 10:24,25
